Using bibliographic references

The must be :

- **Complete**
- **Precise**
- **Homogeneous**
- **Exhaustive but NOT Excessive**

A consistent bibliographic reference style:

BOOK:

Authors surname, initial., *Title of book*. Publisher, city of publication, year

example: Sasso, L. and Aleo, G. (2011) *Pubblicare nella letteratura scientifica internazionale*. Mc Graw Hill, Milano,

Indicate edition after title (e.g. 4th ed.)

BOOK CHAPTER:

example: Smith, J., Allen, V. and Jones, C. (1998) *The importance of publishing* In: Kastin, J. ed. "Publish or perish", 3rd ed. Wiley & co. New York, pp 201-220

Chapter authors Chapter title
Book editor Book title Edition publisher

ARTICLE IN JOURNAL:

Author s (year) *Title of article*. Abbreviated journal name. **Vol**: pages
italics **bold**

example: Rossi, P., Neri, C. and Ferrari G. (2010) *Proline-rich antimicrobial peptides*. J. Biol. Chem. **84**:346-79

Compact style (avoid if you can)

Rossi et al., J. Biol. Chem. **2010**, 84, 346-79

ARTICLE IN ONLINE JOURNAL:

example 1: if possible exactly like hardcopy journal above

example 2 no page numbers: Wilens, T. E., and Biederman, J. (2006). *Alcohol, drugs, and attention-deficit disorder*. J.Psychopharm., **20**. doi:10.1177/0269881105058776 (*digital object identifier*)

example 3 no doi: Williams J. (2008). *The victims of crime*. Sociology Review, 17(4) Available: <http://www.philipallan.co.uk/sociologyreview/index.htm>

WEB PAGE:

Author, (year) *Title*. Available: web address. Accessed: date

indicates the web address

example 1:

example 2: unknown author and/or date:

Anonymous (n.d) *Budapest Open Access Initiative*. Available: <http://www.webcitation.org/query?id=3046>. Accessed: 17 Nov 2005.

*date might be given in text, or indicated as last update, or date after ©
If uncertain put (n.d.) (no date)*
