# Will

I know what I'll do: I will watch some TV.

Shall I open the window?

Will you open the window, please?

If you say that again, I'll [...] kill you!

I will be right back.

# Going to

He said he's going to give a speech.

Look at those clouds. It's going to rain.

She's going to have a baby.

# Will + progressive forms

This time tomorrow I'll be meeting some friends.

I can drop you at the train station: I'll be going that way anyway.

I'm seeing Paul for lunch tomorrow.

We are flying to England next week.
