

## Lectures in Live Streaming

- The MS Teams application will be used for live-streaming lectures until the normal lecturing activities will be established.
- Live Streaming lectures outside the normal lecturing schedule will be organized with the help of the students' representative Luca Secco. Date and time will be communicated via MS Teams messaging. An extra folder will be installed in Moodle.
- Using the MS Teams application, students can get access as "members" to the classroom "Lezione Regolazione Epigenetica":

- For each lecture, an individual live-streaming a channel will be generated. A link will be put on the respective folder in Moodle, before the start of the lecture (ideally the day before).
- Lectures will be registered (audio/video), and will be saved on "streams".
- Please note: problems were observed for uploading the lecture to streams – for the first lectures I cannot guarantee that registration will work smoothly.
- Student behavior during the lecture: switch off microphones and video! Questions can be asked by sending messages. Please consider that the lecture is not a whatsapp chat – we cannot interrupt the lecture too many times. We should try to keep a sort of classic lecture style.
- The slides of the lecture and other materials supporting the contents of the lectures will be uploaded on Moodle
- Permanent storage of live-streaming lectures on "streams" cannot be guaranteed. Lecture slides will stay available on Moodle.
