Evaluation:

1) Fasting one day a week will reduce the amount of calories, and enable people to live longer.

This initial sentence is not suitable. Rhetorically in the discourse it is not the proposal, but functions as a REASON to support the proposal. The PROPOSAL about the desirability of fasting to combat diabetes should come first.

Evaluation:

2) People in the developed world should fast for one day a week because it could reduce the chances of developing obesity-related illnesses like type 2 diabetes, which in turn lead to heart disease, stroke, blindness, kidney failure and amputation.

The first two clauses in the clause complex are fine as a topic sentence. The details about the diabetes-related illnesses should be formulated as a separate sentence.



2) People in the developed world should fast for one day a week because it could reduce the chances of developing obesity-related illnesses like type 2 diabetes. Type 2 diabetes leads in turn to conditions such as heart disease, stroke, blindness, kidney failure and amputation.

Evaluation:

3) If we fasted once a week, we would be able to tackle the obesity epidemic, which is considered by the World Health Organisation to be the world's most neglected health problem.
