The exam will be done on Moodle (on this page) and on Webmeetings Garr

- 1. You should login to Webmeetings Garr ONLY in your time slot (for example, 8-9). DON'T try to login before or after, you will NOT be accepted and will need to take the next exam (prossimo appello).
- 2. You will need a working web cam and a working microphone for the exam.
- 3. The microphone can't be muted and the camera can't be turned off.
- 4. Talking, chatting, browsing the web is NOT allowed during the exam. Any violation automatic expulsion from the exam and reported to University committee.
- 5. Please, familiarize yourself with https://webmeetings.garr.it at least a day before the exam and install the software.

- 6. Prof. Baldoni and I will be watching you the whole time. Any form of cheating will not be tolerated and will result in automatic suspension from the exam.
