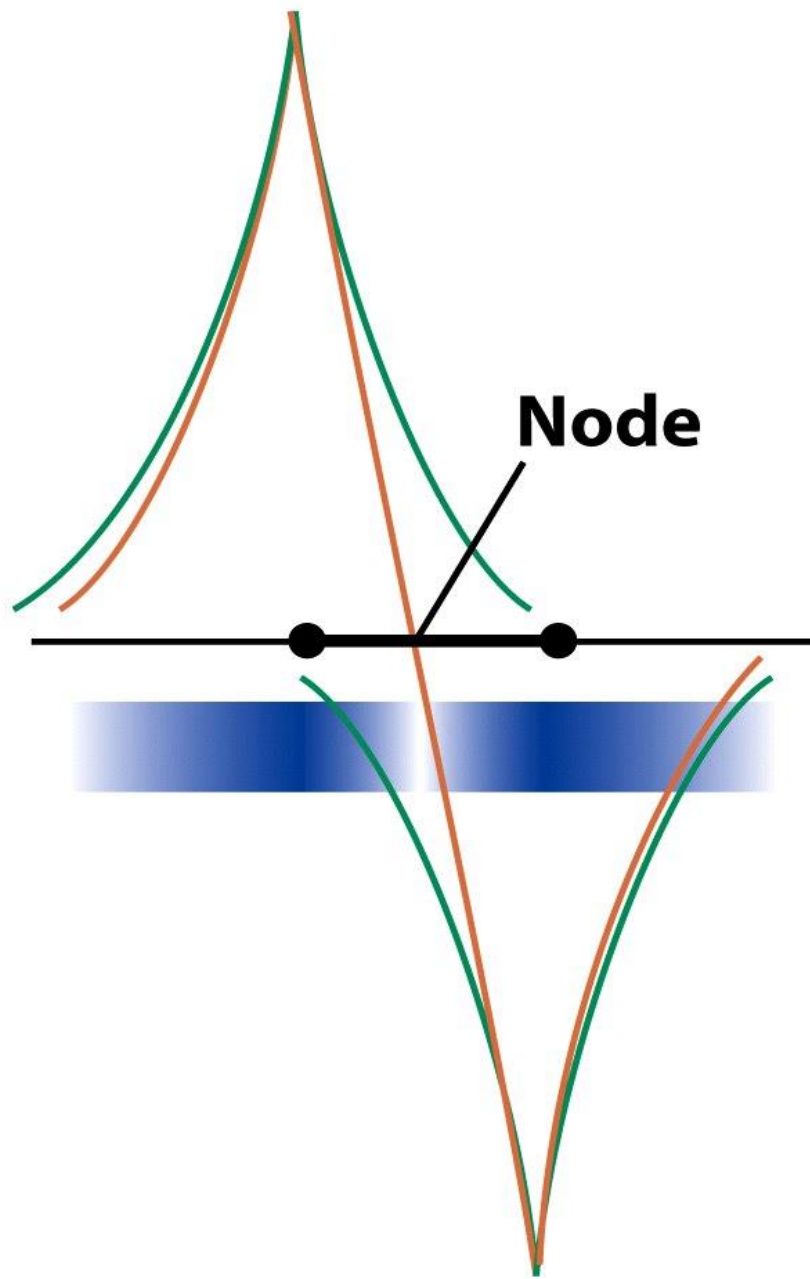


## *Linear Combination of Atomic Orbitals (LCAO)*



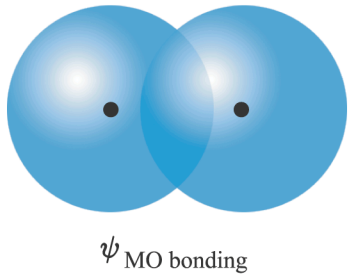

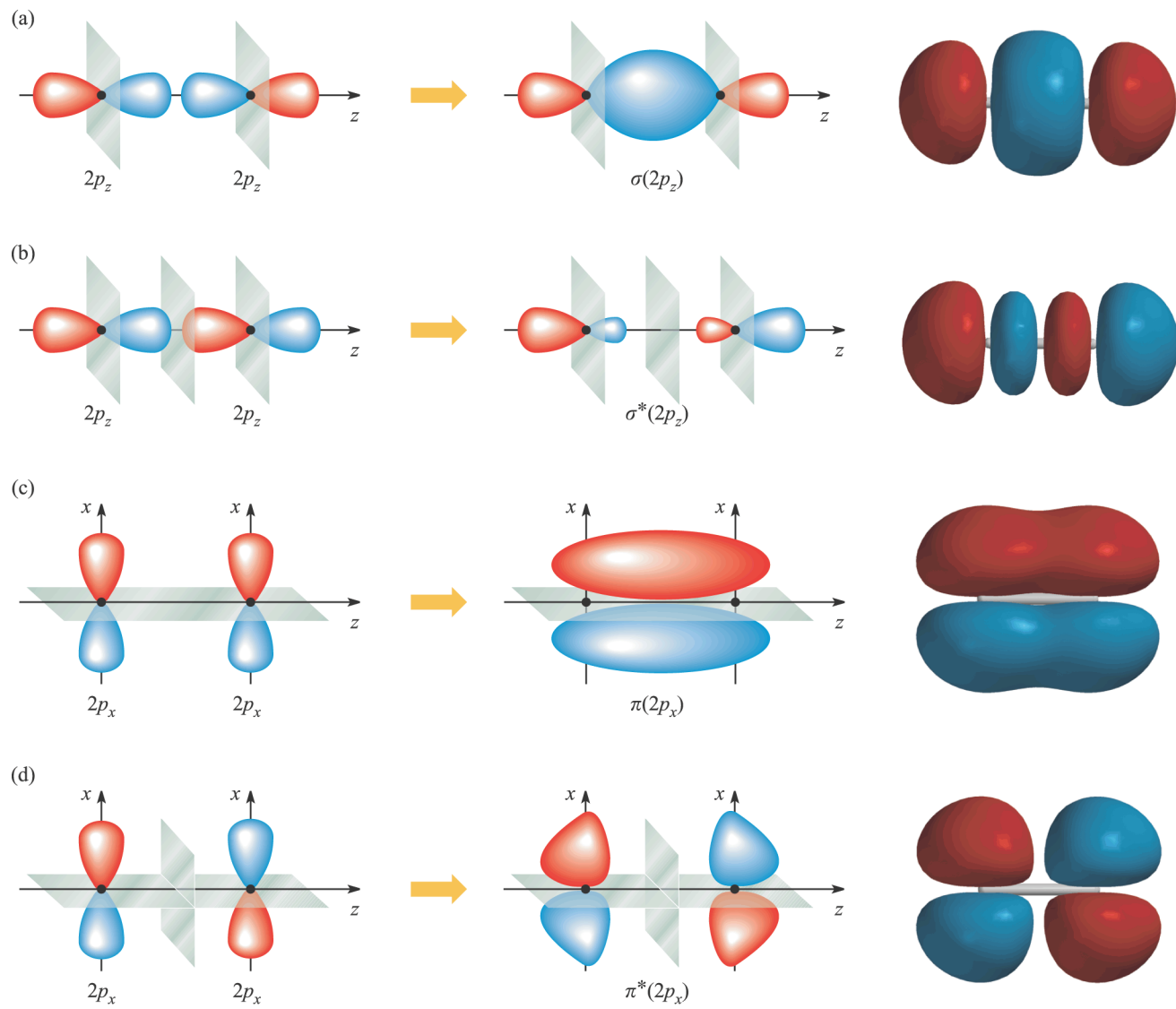


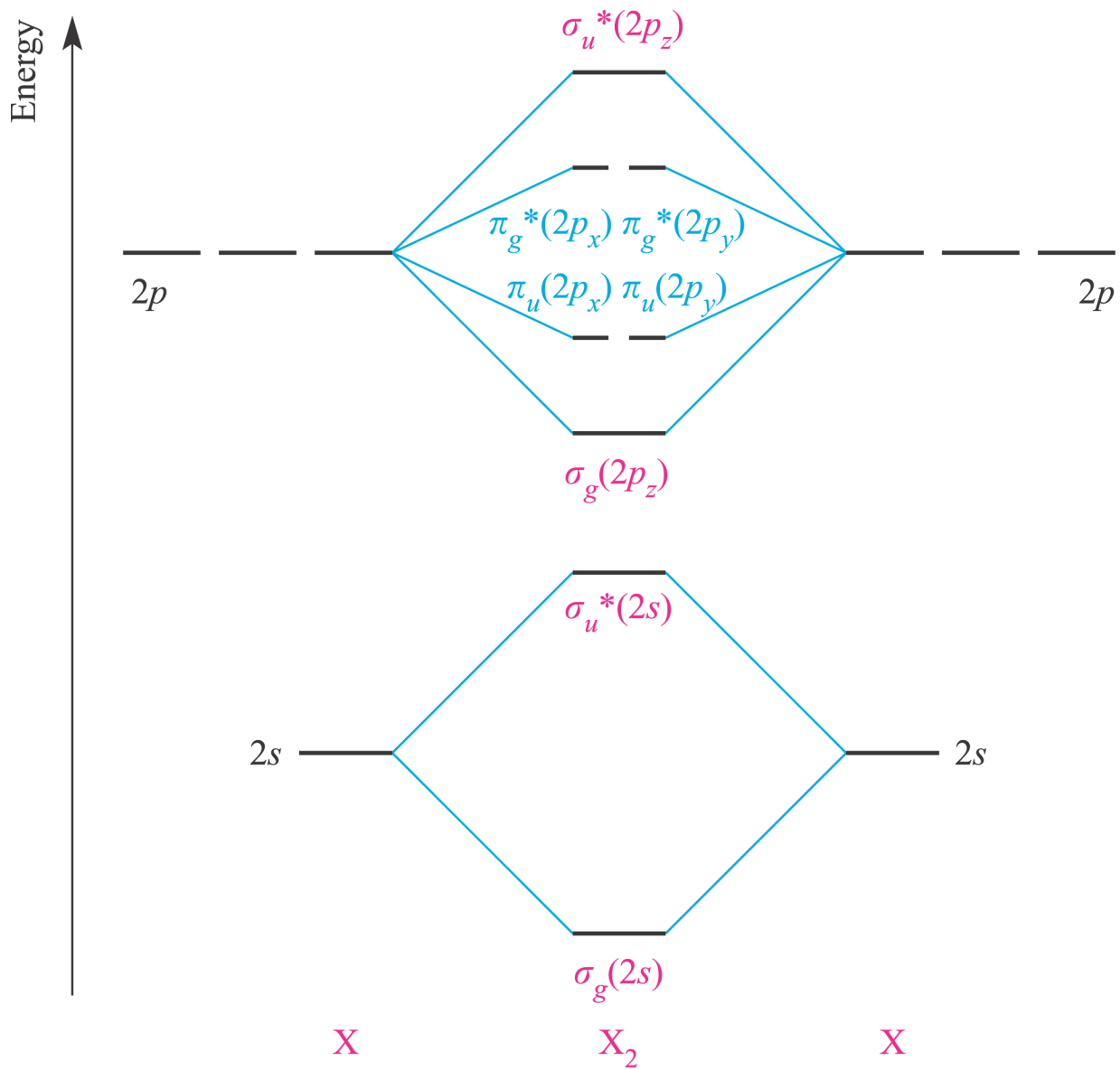
# Interazioni di non-legame



le interazioni tra gli orbitali atomici per dare orbitali molecolari sono:

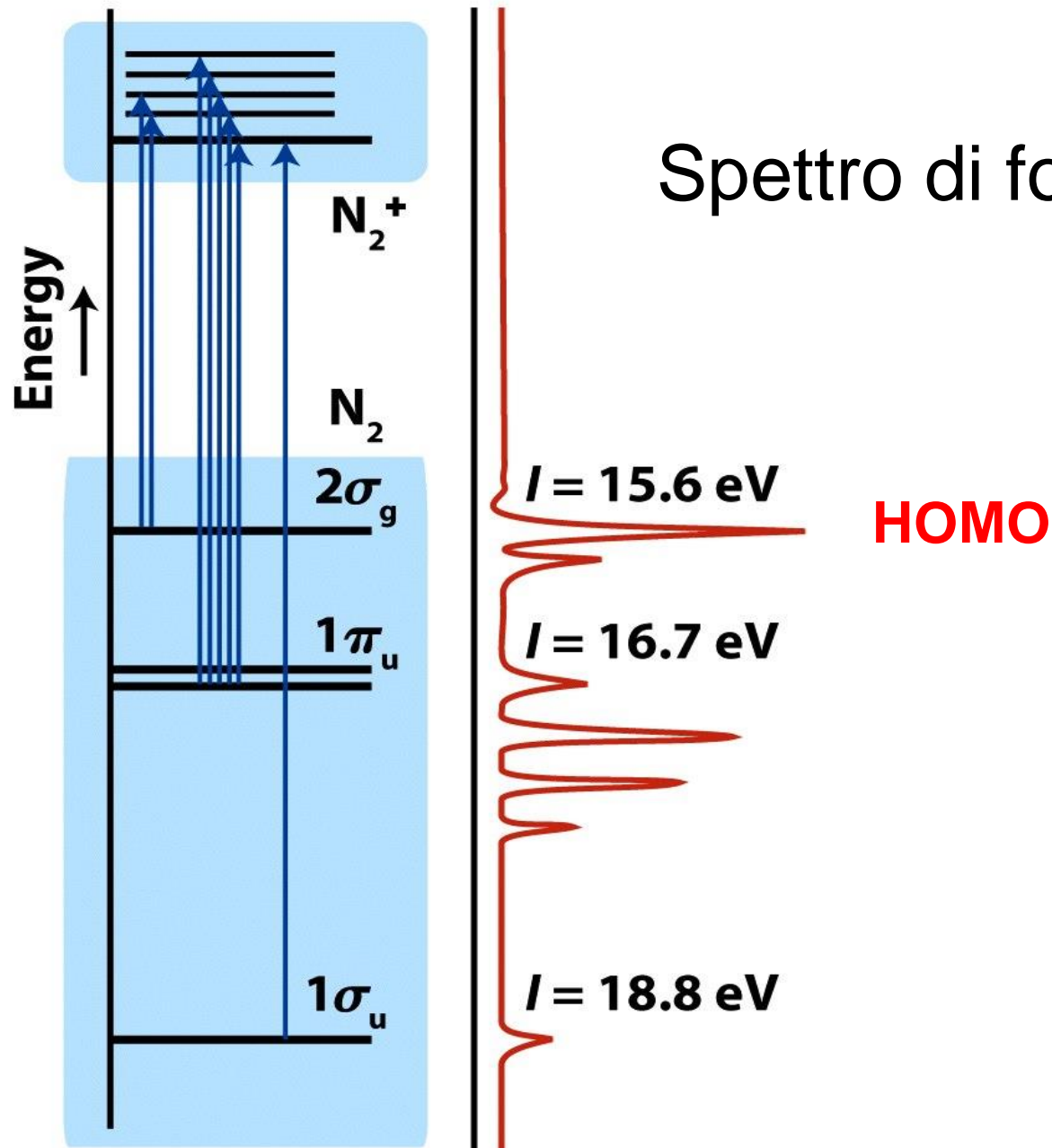
- **permesse** se le simmetrie degli orbitali atomici sono fra loro compatibili;

- **efficaci** se gli orbitali atomici sono relativamente vicini in energia.

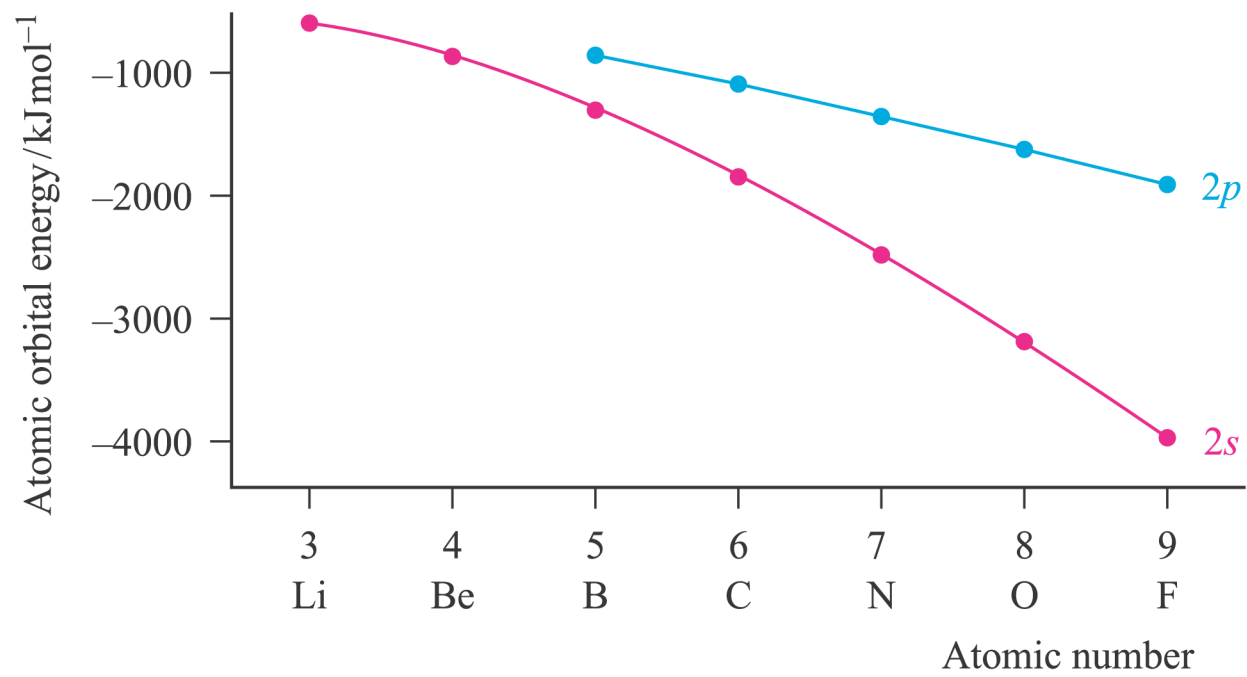


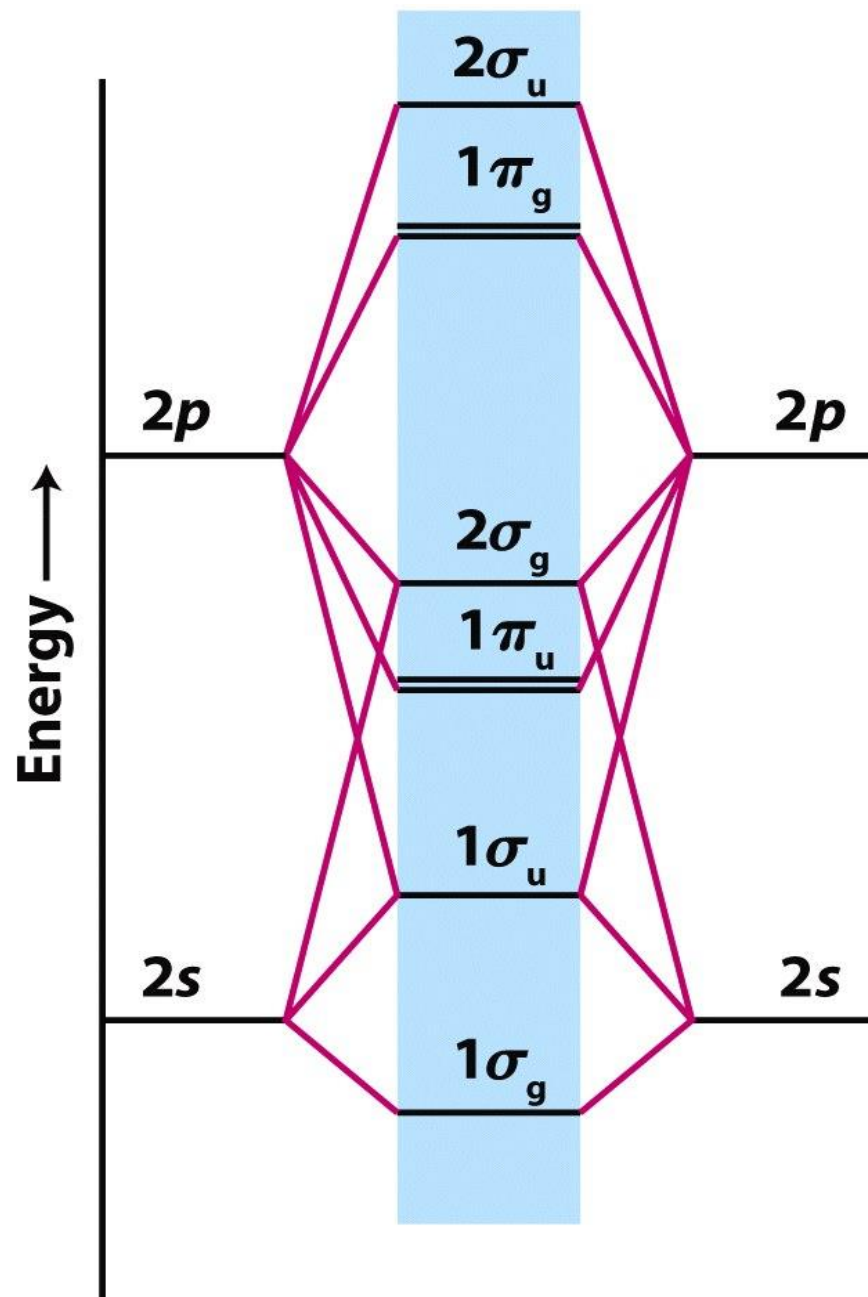

Elettronegatività di Mulliken,  $\chi^M$

$$\chi^M = \frac{1}{2}(I_v + E a_v)$$

$$\chi^{AR} = (3590 \times Z_{\text{eff}}/r_{\text{cov}}^2) + 0.744$$



$\chi^M$  = Mulliken (v = stato di valenza)

$\chi^{AR}$  = Allred e Rochow (elettronegatività = forza elettrostatica esercitata dal nucleo sugli elettroni di valenza)

Dipendenza di  $\chi^M$  da carica parziale  $\delta$  e ibridizzazione

$\chi = a + b\delta$  **equazione di Mulliken-Jaffè** (b = coefficiente di carica)  
 $b = 1/\kappa$  ( $\kappa$  = capacità di carica o **polarizzabilità**)
