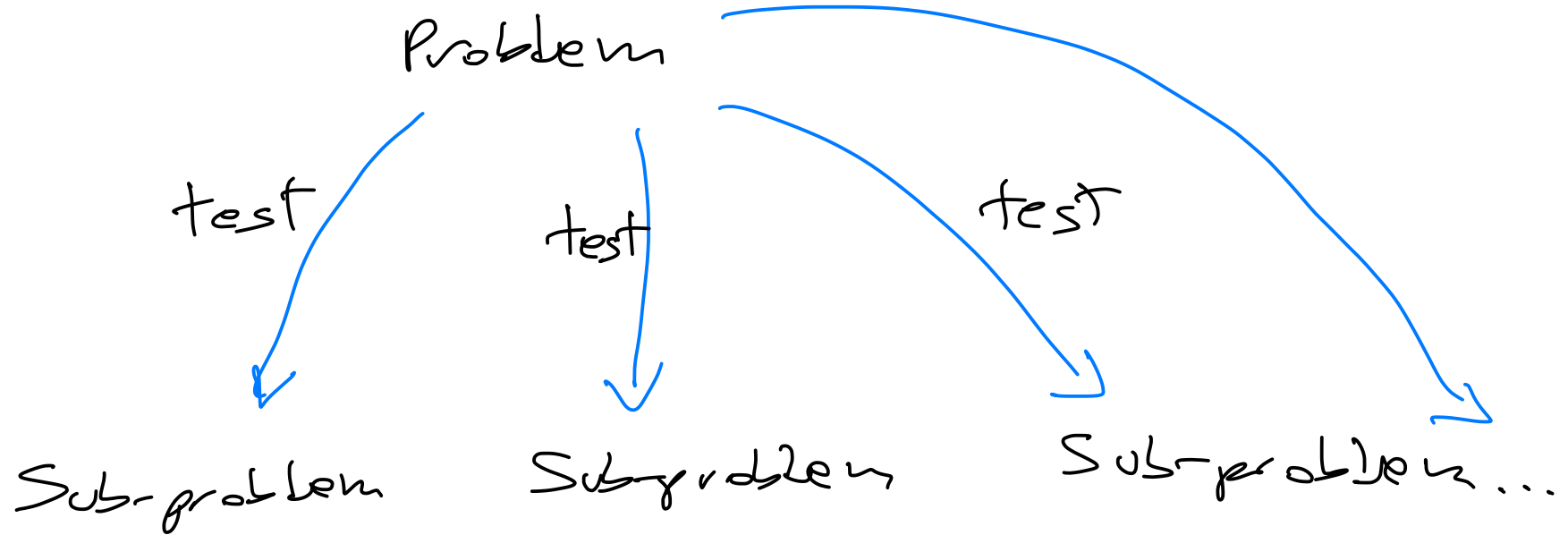


FizzBuzz with and without TDD
