


FIGURE 1.3 Number of Poor by Region, 1990–2030






5.12 UN population scenarios for sub-Saharan Africa (1950–2100)


6.7 GDP growth annual change (1980–2012)








6.4 AIDS treatment recipients (2002–2010) and AIDS-related deaths (2000–2010)











6.16 Wheat yields in developing countries (1961–2012)


5.16 Wheat Yields in Mexico, India, Pakistan (1961–2012)
