#### Key elements of EU funding programme

**Framework programmes** are the main financial tools through which the European Union supports research and development activities covering almost all scientific disciplines. They have multi-annual duration. Ex. HORIZON 2020 or HORIZON EUROPE

**Work Programmes** are annual implementation plans that describe the <u>priority topics</u> of each **Framework Programme** that will be funded during a particular calendar year

**Calls for Proposals** are <u>announcements</u> soliciting proposals in certain topics of the Work Programmes:

- they indicate the topics that need to be addressed by the projects
- ✓ the deadlines for submission
- ✓ the type of projects that can be funded
- ✓ the total budget available

**Type of project** means a sub-programme such as the Marie Curie (MSCA) within the Horizon FP



(RTD)

- Until the 1950s provisions for research were included in the European Coal and Steel Community and the European Atomic Energy Community (Euratom) treaties
- Only in 1984 the first framework programme (FP) was created and approved...
- ... and it became the main funding instrument for research and innovation
- Since then, the European Union has run its research and innovation policy and funding on the basis of multiannual framework programmes

#### The first framework programme

- The 1st Framework Programme lasted 5 years from 1984 to 1988
- The sectors involved were energy (largely nuclear fission) which absorbed 50% of the budget –, information and communication technologies (ICT, 25%), industry and materials (11%), science of life and the environment (10%)
- Part of the funds were intended for mobility and scholarships
- The total budget was 3.75 billion euros
