




### Kingdom of Halych-Volynia (1245-1349)

Kingdom of Halych-Volynia was one of the several most important powers to emerge from the collapse of Kyivan Rus' in 1240. After the Mongol invasion, in 1245 Pope Innocent IV allowed prince Danylo to be crowned king. Under Danylo's reign, Kingdom of Halych-Volynia was one of the most powerful states in east central Europe. Over 80 culturally rich towns and cities were located in the Kingdom.
