The individual had spent the evening <u>drinking</u> with friends and was over the legal alcohol limit when he drove his car home. The individual received a text message and was <u>checking</u> the message on his phone, which caused him to be distracted. As a result, he did not see the oncoming vehicle. He was unable to stop in time and crashed into the other vehicle. <u>Both</u> vehicles were severely damaged. The individual sustained a <u>broken wrist</u> in the accident. Initially he seemed otherwise unharmed and spoke to the police officers. However, after 10 minutes he began to <u>speak in a confused manner</u>, and later fell into a <u>coma</u>. Surgeons operated on him and removed a blood clot from his brain. Although the individual recovered from the coma, he was subsequently <u>paralysed</u> and will <u>spend the remainder of his life in a wheelchair</u>.
