I worked for the fiscal office (OCR) of this enterprise, which offers services for SMEs located in Emilia-Romagna (the region where I live). My task consisted in keeping track of clients' invoices and registering them in the Lapam's database thanks to a type of software invented by the company itself, named 'Digital Lapam OCR'. The software elaborated invoices but had to be trained to read all templates used by Lapam's clients, so we checked its preliminary results and filled in the blank fields it did not manage to properly register. All these processes were very fast, and I managed to reach registering almost nine hundred invoices per day. However, the office almost closed due to the advent of stereotyped automatic invoicing in 2019.

**City councillor** After carrying on my electoral campaign while I was on Erasmus, I managed to be elected city councillor of my hometown for a left-wing list, 'Centrosinistra per Reggiolo', on May 26th, 2019. which committed to the re-election of the at-that-time mayor in my hometown, Roberto Angeli. I currently participate in the monthly assemblies of the entire council of my municipality and in the regular meetings of my party group, discuss local arrangements and steps to adopt to improve Reggiolo, while giving a help to arrange and conduct events there. Thanks to my role, I also had the opportunity to meet and interview both the now Labor Minister Orlando, in 2019, and the President of Emilia Romagna Bonaccini (in 2021) during their visits at my home place.

Thanks to this role, I also served as volunteer during the first wave of the Covid-19 pandemic, by doing the shopping to elderly or people who could not go out because of Coronavirus.

Since October 2021, I also am the representative of Reggiolo in the context of Be4Europe, a project of the Bassa Reggiana Union (an administrative unit gathering my hometown and other close municipalities) which is committed to education and sensibilization of citizenships and local administrative figures about the role of the EU at a local level. At the end of the cycle of workshops and meetings (funded through EU funds), it will also be evaluated the realization of a local 'Punto Europa', acting as hub of interest to economic and political stakeholders with respect to EU initiatives and fundings.
