# Examination Guidelines: Bash and Python Programming

To complete the examination, candidates must follow the instructions below regarding the project choice, submission method, and scheduling.

## 1. Examination Format

Candidates have the flexibility to choose between two options for their practical assessment:

- **Personal Project:** Develop a project of your own design in either **Bash** or **Python**. This option is subject to **prior agreement** with the instructor to ensure the scope is appropriate.
- **Assigned Exercises:** Complete a specific set of exercises in either **Bash** or **Python** (of your choice) assigned directly by the instructor.

## 2. Submission Requirements

Regardless of the option chosen, all work (including source code, documentation, and any necessary configuration files) must be submitted via a **GitHub repository**.

**Note:** Please ensure the repository is public or that the instructor has been granted access before the discussion.

## 3. Scheduling and Exam Dates

There are **no official fixed dates** for the exam sessions. This course adopts a flexible scheduling policy:

- Candidates are free to contact the instructor at any time throughout the academic year when they feel ready to take the exam.
- The first step is to get in touch with the instructor to discuss and finalise **Point 1** (choosing between a personal project or assigned exercises).
- Once the work is ready, a date for the oral discussion will be scheduled individually.
